

DMP Students Arranged a Virtual Book Review Competition Based on the Renowned Book of Selina Hossain 'Hangor Nodi Grenade'

As part of engaging students in extra-curricular activities during pandemic situations, the Developing Midwives Project has successfully organised a virtual book review competition in June 2021 on the renowned book of Selina Hossain 'Hangor Nodi Grenade'.

Prior to reviewing competition DMP, the BRACU team made available the soft copy of the selected book in seven academic sites. A total of 102 students participated in this competition and among them, 15 reviewers were selected for the final evaluation. The students analyzed and wrote their views on the novel. The reviewers focused on the background of the novel, author's introduction, the context of the novel i.e., a subject addressed, characters, time period and language used in the novel, storyline, rationale for naming the book, overall understating of the students by reading the book etc.

Finally, the top three reviewers from GBC-CHP, Dhaka Urban and Shimantik academic sites were crowned the winner of the final book review competition.
